Item No 1	Confirmation of minutes of 18th Academic Council meeting held on Tuesday, April 20, 2021.
Minutes of 18 th Meeting of the Academic Council held on April 20, 2021 were confirmed.	

Item No 2	Matters Related to Academic Affairs
<p>i) Presentation on revised curriculum for M.Tech Internet of Things</p> <p>Proposal for implementation of scheme and course contents for M.Tech Internet of Things to be implemented from academic year 2021-22 are presented by the respective Head of Electrical Department.</p> <p>After deliberation and discussion, the Academic Council approved curriculum, scheme of instruction and evaluation subject to changes to align proposals to standard template (including max theory hours, maximum lab hours, maximum credit courses, total maximum credits, etc.) and implementation of minor suggestions given in curriculum by academic council members.</p> <p>The Academic Council also authorized the Chairman Academic Council to approve minor alterations in course content as well as changes in course outcomes.</p> <p>ii) Presentation on Academic Calendar for AY 2021-22.</p> <p>Dean Academic Programme presented the Academic Calendar of even semester of Second to Final years B.Tech and MCA Program for AY 2021-22 and Odd and Even semesters for First Year B.Tech, M.Tech and MCA Program for AY 2021-22 After Discussion and deliberation, the Academic Council approved the presented Academic Calendar (Annexure-I) and also authorized the Chairman Academic Council to approve minor changes as per the directives of University of Mumbai and State Government of Maharashtra.</p> <p>iii) Renaming the M.Tech Courses from Computer &IT Department.</p> <p>HoD, Computer and Information Technology Department briefed the Academic Council rationale behind renaming the M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization Software Engineering course as M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization in Data Science and M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization Network Infrastructure Management System course as M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization in Cyber Security. He informed that, presently in computer engineering the cutting edge technology are Data Science, Cyber Security and Internet of Things.</p>	





After discussion and deliberation, Academic Council approved renaming of M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization Software Engineering course as M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization in Data Science and M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization Network Infrastructure Management System course as M.Tech Computer Engineering with Specialization in Cyber Security

It is also discussed that it is necessary to keep at least one interdisciplinary course at M.Tech level and all department shall offer one such interdisciplinary course which will attract the students from other department.

v) Extension to UG/PG students who have completed the duration of program.

Dean Academic Briefed to the Academic Council that few UG and PG students who could not complete their program within stipulated time period had requested the DAC of the respective program/department for extension to complete the program. Few students also requested for grade improvement/repeat the course etc. Respective DAC has approved the request of students and recommended for approval of the Academic Council. List of students and their request is presented in Annexure -II.


The Academic Council approved the extension of students listed in Annexure-II for one year as special case to complete the program subject to undertaking from students that they will additional fees for extended period and approval given for these students shall not be used as reference in future.

Item No 3 Matters related to Ph.D affairs

i) Presentation on syllabus of Research and Publication- Ethics & Methodologies Course- Mandatory course to Ph.D students.

Dean Research, Development and Consultancy informed the Academic Council that the University Grant commission in its 543rd meeting held on 9th August 2019 approved the two credit course on "Research and Publication Ethics (RPE)" and made it mandatory for all Ph.D students. He further briefed that present Research Methodology course offered to Ph.D students and proposed Research and Publication Ethic course having few overlapping course contents. Therefore, it is proposed to combine both the courses and offer a single course of 4 credits which will cover all course content of both the courses.

After deliberation and discussion, the Academic Council approved curriculum, scheme of instruction and evaluation subject to changes to implementation of minor suggestions given by academic council members. The Academic Council also authorized the Chairman Academic Council to approve minor alteration in course content as well as changes in course outcomes. It is decided that the course will be initially offered at institute level in first semester of PhD course-work.



ii) Extension to Ph.D. students who have completed the duration of program.

Dean Research, Development and Consultancy briefed the Academic Council that few Ph.D students who could not complete their program within stipulated time period had requested to DAC of the respective program/department for extension to complete the program.. Respective DAC and Ph.D affair committee recommended the request of students for approval of the Academic Council. List of students and their request is presented in Annexure -III.

The Academic Council approved the extension of students listed in Annexure-III for one year as special case to complete the program subject to undertaking from students that they will additional fees for extended period and approval given for these students shall not be used as reference in future.

iii) Cancellation of Ph.D Admission of students as per the recommendation of DAC.

Dean Research, Development and Consultancy informed the Academic Council that the PhD Affairs Committee deliberated the issue and decided to recommend the cancellation of PhD admissions of the student Mr Bhushan Joshi from electrical engineering department. Academic Council approved the cancellation of admissions of PhD scholars Mr Bhushan Joshi from Electrical Engineering Department.

Item No 4 Any other matter with permission of Chair

Approval to Start M.Tech in Defence Technology Course from AY 2021-22


Dean Academic briefed to the Academic council that as per the advertisement given by AICTE, Institute applied to the AICTE to start the M.Tech Defence Technology Course from AY 2021-22. AICTE and State Government of Maharashtra has given approval to start this course from AY 2021-22 with 30 intake capacity. He also briefed that eligibility criteria for admission, detailed curriculum and mode of conduct of this course are given by the AICTE in detail. As per guidelines given by the AICTE this course will be offered by the VJTI from AY 2021-22. He further informed that due to the limited time line, prior approval of the academic council is not obtained to start this course.

The academic council took on the record the approval given by AICTE and State Government of Maharashtra, and post facto approval was given to start M.Tech Defence Technology course from AY 2021-22.
