Admissions to B.TECH Programme in Engineering Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1) How do I get admission to VJTI for B. TECH?

ANS: Admissions for B. TECH for various courses at Veermata Jijabai Technological Institute (VJTI, Mumbai) are done through Centralized Admission Process that is conducted by State CET Cell, Maharashtra State through its portal <https://cetcell.mahacet.org/>

2) How the admissions are done at VJTI?

ANS: Admissions at VJTI are done purely on the basis of merit of MHT CET for Engineering Courses through CAP allotment by State CET Cell, Maharashtra State.

3) Is there any Management Quota for admissions at VJTI?

ANS: No, VJTI, being a Maharashtra Govt. Aided Institute, It does not have any management quota for admissions.

4) Which Degree Courses in Engineering are available at VJTI?

ANS: VJTI offers four year undergraduate courses in Computer Engineering, Information Technology, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Production Engineering and Textile Engineering. 5) Does VJTI have CIWGC/OCI/PIO/FN/NRI Quota for admissions?

6) How do I get admission through lateral entry for Direct Second Year Engineering?

ANS: Admissions through lateral entry for Direct Second Year B.TECH for various courses at Veermata Jijabai Technological Institute (VJTI, Mumbai) are done through Centralized Admission Process that is conducted by State CET Cell, Maharashtra State through its portal <https://cetcell.mahacet.org/>

10) When will the admission process for start?

ANS: Admission process for undergraduate courses in Engineering begins only after the registration process for Centralized Admission Process begins at <https://cetcell.mahacet.org/> (usually after MHT CET results are declared) by State CET Cell, Maharashtra State.

11) Do I need to apply at VJTI for admission separately?

ANS: No. If the candidate is participating in the admission process through Centralized Admission Process then such candidate need not apply to VJTI separately.

12) Do I need to apply at VJTI for admission under CIWGC/OCI/PIO/FN/NRI?

ANS: Yes, the candidate seeking admission under CIWGC/OCI/PIO/FN/NRI quota need to apply separately as and when application are invited in the prescribed format. (This is only after such candidate register for CIWGC/OCI/PIO/FN/NRI candidature through mahacet.org and verifies his or her eligibility through scrutiny process).

13) Whom should I contact for queries related to admission process?
