The following were the suggestions made by Dr. D.B. Phatak in connection with proposed guidelines for emeritus Professorship

- 1. Maximum age limit for holding position should be raised to 70 years from the proposed 65 year.
- 2. The title Emeritus Professor is not jelling well with the proposal because Emeritus Professor is an honorary title, and the proposed guidelines are for reemployment. Therefore Director in consultation with the committee constituted to prepare the guidelines should decide a suitable title.

Net Banking facility shall also be availed for viewing rights for the Institute accounts.

5. Approval for change of nomenclature of the DTC program

Taking into account the concern shown by Director MSBTE in the capacity of Chairman examination committee in connection with large number of seats remaining vacant in Diploma in Technical Chemistry(DTC) program, and the suggestion given by him for changing the name of the program from DTC to Diploma in Chemical Engineering(DCE) since the curriculum has 50% subjects equivalent to Chemical Engineering. BoG approved the proposal for initiating the process for changing the name of the program Diploma in Technical Chemistry(DTC) to Diploma in Chemical Engineering(DCE).

6. <u>Proposal to felicitate Distinguished Alumnus Mr. Amit Chandra, Electrical Engineering 1989 batch.</u>

Dr. R D Daruwala briefed the BoG members about the achievements of Mr. Amit Chandra as a well known investment banker and business leader of Indian commerce and industry.
