The United Nations Academic Impact (<u>UNAI</u>) is an initiative that engages institutions of higher education in supporting UN goals, including the promotion and protection of human rights, access to education, sustainability and conflict resolution.

One of their key initiatives is their network of students, academics, scientists, researchers, think tanks, institutions of higher education, continuing education and educational associations. These are over 1,600 member institutions in more than 150 countries that reach over 25 million people in the education and research sectors around the world.

UNAI assists these stakeholders by disseminating information on UN initiatives and activities, providing ideas on how these activities can be applied at the local level on college campuses, in classrooms and in communities, and by providing a platform where university students, academics and researchers can connect and share ideas, research and resources to further the Sustainable Development Goals and other UN mandates.
