How to Reach

1. From Central Line

☒ Get off at: SION Station

- Sion is directly on the **Central Line** (between Kurla and Matunga).
- After getting off:
 - Take a **share auto / rickshaw** to "Shanmukhananda Hall" (~₹20–30).
 - Or **walk 10–15 mins** via Comrade Harbanslal Marg toward Gandhi Market.

2. From Western Line

☒ Get off at: DADAR (Western) → Change to Central Line

- Take a **local train to Dadar (Western)**.
- Walk across the bridge to **Dadar (Central)** (same station complex).
- From **Dadar (Central)**, board a train towards **Kurla/Thane** and get down at **Sion** (next station).
- Then take an **auto** or **walk** to the auditorium.

▲ **Important:** There is *no direct station at Sion* on the Western Line — you must change to the Central Line at **Dadar**.

3. From Harbour Line

☒ Get off at: KING'S CIRCLE Station

- King's Circle is on the **Harbour Line** (in the Bandra–CST route).
- From there:
 - Walk (~10–15 minutes) to the auditorium.
 - Or take a **short rickshaw ride**.

● Do **not** get off at Wadala Road or other Harbour Line stations unless you're switching.
