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VJTI Mumbai – Internship and Campus Recruitment Policy for Visiting Companies (AY 2026-27)

Welcome Message

The Training and Placement Office (TPO) of Veermata Jijabai Technological Institute (VJTI), Mumbai, extends a warm welcome to all recruiting organizations and expresses its sincere gratitude for their continued association/ interest in collaborating with the Institute. The Training and Placement Office serves as a neutral facilitator to ensure a transparent, efficient, and mutually beneficial recruitment process for both recruiters and students.

In alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the Institute promotes experiential learning through internships, industry projects, research assignments, and collaborative academic-industry initiatives. To maintain fairness, transparency, and clarity in the internship and placement process, we request your attention to the following guidelines.

Semester-Long Internship Framework

In alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 students may undertake a semester-long internships and below are the internship options:

- B.Tech students may undertake a 6-month internship during Semester VIII (January–June 2027).
- MCA students may undertake a 6-month internship during Semester VI (January–June 2027).
- M.Tech students may undertake industry-aligned 11-months Project Thesis Work in collaboration with industry during Semesters III & IV (i.e. 2nd year of M.Tech), subject to departmental approval from July 2026 - June 2027. Industry is required to declare the thesis topic or research area or work domain before the interview process so that Supervisor (i.e. respective VJTI Professor) and industry guide can discuss the mutual interest of the research area.
- B.Tech students can also undertake 45 days summer internship in between 6th & 7th Semester (Duration June to Mid July 2027: Strictly 45 days only). Once academic session begins or after 15th July, internship will be automatically closed.

Recruitment Process and Communication

- Companies are allotted campus dates based on a combination of parameters including job profile and growth prospects, CTC offered, past recruitment record at VJTI, and student feedback.
- Job Application Form (JAF)/ Internship Announcement Form (IAF) is mandatory to submit in advance, clearly stating requirements. Without clear mention of CTC/Stipend it shall not be accepted.
- All offer-related communication shall be routed through the Training and Placement Office (TPO) only. Direct correspondence with students is discouraged.
- Companies approaching faculty members directly for recruitment or internship opportunities are requested to submit their requirements through the prescribed Job Application Form (JAF)/ Internship Announcement Form (IAF) and route all official communication through the TPO email tpo@vjti.ac.in

Offer Declaration and Acceptance

- Results should preferably be declared on the same day and before 11:59 PM so that selected students can be marked out of database for next drive.
- If a student receives more than one offer on the same day, the first offer extended shall be treated as final and all subsequent offers shall stand withdrawn.
- Selected students are expected to communicate their acceptance within the stipulated timeline communicated by the TPO.

Pre-Placement Offers (PPOs)

- Companies are encouraged to release PPO decisions by mid-July, as the final placement season generally commences during the third week of July.
- For B.Tech students, a PPO offering less than ₹10 LPA shall be treated as a placement offer; however, the student may continue to participate in subsequent placement drives as per the Institute's placement policy.
- A PPO offering ₹10 LPA and above shall be considered final and binding, and the student shall ordinarily not be eligible to participate in further placement drives.
- For M.Tech and MCA students, only one-offer policy is applicable.

CTC-Based Company Categorization (Applicable to B.Tech Programmes)

Normal	CSE, IT, EXTC, Electronics	Below ₹14 LPA
	Civil, Electrical, Mechanical, Production, Textile	Below ₹10 LPA
Dream	CSE, IT, EXTC, Electronics	₹14 LPA and above
	Civil, Electrical, Mechanical, Production, Textile	₹10 LPA and above
Super Dream	All Branches	₹30 LPA and above

- A student placed in a particular category may avail only one opportunity for upgradation to a higher category company during the placement cycle.
- Companies are requested to clearly mention CTC details, compensation structure, and benefits in the JAF to enable informed decision-making by students.
- M.Tech and MCA students shall be governed by a one-offer policy and betterment shall not be applicable.

Betterment Gap Rule (*Only for B.Tech*)

To qualify as a betterment offer, in a **higher category (e.g. Regular to Dream or Dream to Super Dream)**, the offered CTC must exceed the previous accepted offer by at least:

- Computer Engineering, Information Technology, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering, and Electronics Engineering: ₹6 LPA
- Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Production Engineering, and Textile Engineering: ₹3 LPA

Internship Planning and Placement Coordination

- The Institute follows an integrated approach towards internship and placement planning to ensure alignment between academic requirements and recruitment activities.
- Recruiters are encouraged to complete internship hiring processes, wherever possible, by 15 December to facilitate smooth academic and administrative planning.
